Application: Amos is asking a rhetorical question in this verse. Many books are written every year describing the keys to a successful life, marriage, family or business. One of the most important factors of success for a marriage is the partnership that forms between husband and wife. Just as successful teams are both strategic and supportive, a couple must also agree on a plan or they will begin to drift apart. When a couple takes the time to pray for discernment and wisdom when making decisions, they will avoid chasing self-serving dreams and goals that could prove to be destructive to their relationship, business and family.
